Right to participate

The Nordic Championships 2001 is open for all gymnasts from the Nordic countries taking part in Frivolten Cup. All competitors from Sweden, Norway, Iceland, Finland and Denmark competing in Frivolten Cup Open and Junior will automatically take part in the Nordic Championships. There is no extra entry fee for participating in the Nordic Championships.

Competition format

The result of the Nordic Championships 2001 will be calculated on the basis of the results obtained in Frivolten Cup Open or Junior. A separate result list will be issued and a separate prize ceremony will take place.

Finalists and Finals

In Frivolten Cup, the gymnasts with the eight (8) best scores from the Qualifying Round will participate in the final. In addition to that, the gymnasts from the Nordic countries with the eight (8) best scores from the Qualifying Round will be allowed to participate in the final. The gymnasts who qualify for the final only due to the "Nordic quota" will not be competing for medals in Frivolten Cup.

Winners and medals

The winner is the gymnast with the highest overall number of points.

Nordic Championships medals will be awarded to no. 1, 2 and 3 in each event.

Note: Medals will be awarded regardless of the number of participating gymnasts and/or countries in any one event.

Judges

All participating federations must bring at least one judge with a current FIG Judges Brevet (minimum Category 3). The judges panels will be decided by the SvGF Trampoline TC.

Insurance

This is compulsory and the responsibility of each participant. The Swedish Gymnastics Federation or GK Frivolten will not accept any responsibility whatsoever.
